

## Worksheet for the passing day of Lady Khadijah (SA)

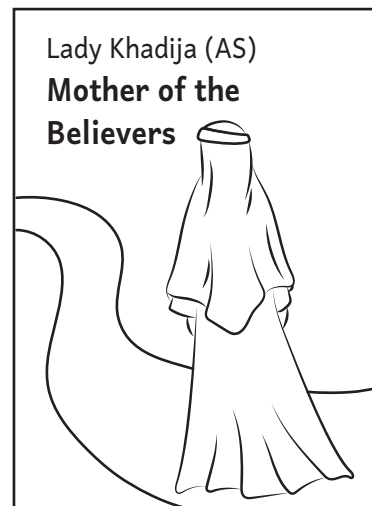
